People interested in art, writing, puppetry, and theater are currently being enrolled in a special residency to learn basic skills in designing, carving, painting, and manipulating shadow characters. Age range 6* and above.

*Please note that due to the sharp tools involved in carving characters, youth aged 6 to 12 must work one on one with a parent, adult, or older sibling.

Enrollment Procedure:

2. Plan on attending all eleven sessions. Don't worry if you can't, however, it will benefit you to attend every session.
3. Hands-on class sessions will be held every Saturday afternoon from February 4th through April 1st* from 1:00 to 3:00 PM at the Onion (Sepulveda Unitarian Universalist Society SUUS), 9550 Haskell Ave in North Hills.

 - Session #11 - Culmination exhibit/performance - Saturday, April 1st - 11:00 AM Load in the Onion - 12:30 PM Run Through 2 PM Doors Open 2:30 PM Performance 4-4:30 Load Out
